

The islands of Ryfylke – from Sand

(Note that tent campers in public recreation areas are limited to two days per campsite.)

- **Sand:** Bunkering, an excellent guest harbour with facilities, shopping, cafés, a hotel and other services.

- **Sjubbeholsvågen:** This nice harbour, which is almost completely sheltered, is situated at Vatlandsvåg on the south side of Ropeidhalvøya peninsula. Guest boat wharf, path along the harbour, and trails throughout the recreation area.

Bunkering at Vatlandsvåg. If you wish to continue by boat in Ryfylke, there is accommodation in Nedstrand. This charming village has a marina and camping, with all necessary facilities. Bunkering.

- **Nord-Talgje in Sjernerøyane archipelago:** The area consists of islands, skerries and islets, sounds and many sheltered coves – a very popular boating destination with space for everyone. Facilities include toilets, mooring hooks, waste disposal and recycling station, and information board. Land-based accommodation is available at Helgøysund Fiskesenter at Helgøy in the Sjernerøyane archipelago, but do call ahead for reservations. In addition, there is Eldhuset bed & breakfast at Nord-Hidle near Hildesundet sound, which is well known for its excellent home cooking!

- **Rossøysundet (Finnøy):** A peninsula, sound and island at Fogn's southern point. The coast here is characterised by sloping rockfaces, and sheltered coves and sounds that offer many tempting places to cast anchor. Facilities in the area include handicap toilet, waste disposal and recycling station, guest harbour and marked trails. Accommodation is available at Finnøy Fjordsenter (on the eastern shore of Finnøy, at Nåden, south of Judaberg), where there are cabins and camping with sanitary facilities and other amenities. In Judaberg you can re-fuel 24 hours a day with a credit card or bankcard.

- A stop at **Søre Børøyholmen** is recommended if you wish to experience the natural beauty of the islands of Ryfylke. This idyllic islet lies just south of Børøy island on the Fisterfjord. Facilities include handicap toilets, information signs, rest area with picnic tables, waste disposal and recycling station, mooring hooks, a barbecue area, and a

wharf. Land-based accommodation is available at Fister Camp at Fister, and at Spa-hotell Velvære in Hjelmelandsvågen. Automated re-fuelling near the ferry quay at Hjelmeland: petrol 9am–9.30pm, diesel day and night.

- **Skaholmen Berget on the Økstrafjord (Suldal):** The beacon at Barkeneset shows safe sailing back into the Økstrafjord. Skaholmen Berget lies on the western shore, an area with polished rockfaces, islets, promontories, caves and sounds. There are many idyllic spots to cast anchor or moor your boat, and many of the islets are joined by small bridges. One of the attractions is potholes carved by natural forces. Facilities include toilets, wharf, mooring hooks, waste disposal, information boards and paths. Re-fuel 24 hours a day at Foreneset. Sanitary facilities for boat tourists are also available at Erøy country store. You will also find land-based accommodation at Fuglestein Fjordferie at Foreneset.

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
